At this stage already I would like to thank our colleagues from Holland very warmly for the preparation of the great event and their enthousiasme!

Our Assembly 2009 will be remembered as a special landmark in the history of EVL since it is proposed to merge with our partner organisation of young musicians EAYO. You may recall that at the Assembly 2006 a working group was instituted and mandated with the examination and preparation of the details of joining the two organisations into one. In order to allow you to get familiar with this project you will find in the attachment the **draft statutes**. We would like to invite you to let us have your questions and comments by **March 30, 2009**.

Given these special circumstances the two Associations will hold their regular Assemblies at the same time at Dalfsen. They will be followed by a joint assembly to discuss and to decide upon the merger issue. In case you will agree with joining forces, the Founding Assembly will follow to bring the new European Orchestra Federation EOFED to life.
